

2010-2011 Texas A&M Ram Test Sale Report

The 2010-2011 Texas A&M Ram Performance Test sale was held on March 18, 2011. Sixteen rams sold for an average price of \$794. The high selling ram was TAES 8687, from Texas Agrilife Research. He sold to Sawyer Ranch of Sonora for \$2200. This year's high index ram was TAES 8721 also from Texas AgriLife Research. He sold for \$700 to Bill Karnes of Sonora. The highest selling 3 rams were all sired by TAES 8287 who is currently the highest ranked ram for fineness on the 2011 sire summary. Several rams that were offered in the sale did not obtain the minimum bid of \$400.
